ALWAYS IN THERE

the short list that matters

- ☐ Sturdy shoes — one pair per person
- ☐ Head protection — bike, sports or work helmet
- ☐ Torch per person, plus spare batteries
- ☐ Whistle per person (plastic, not metal)
- ☐ Sealed bottled water, rotated yearly
- ☐ Small first aid kit that stays put
- ☐ Blankets
- ☐ Weather radio or charged power bank

ADD IF YOU CAN

what people forget

- ☐ Medication — a few days of anything essential
- ☐ Written list of household medication
- ☐ Spare phone charger that never leaves the shelter
- ☐ Work gloves
- ☐ Bucket with a lid, and bags
- ☐ Pet carrier or lead

PER PERSON

the ones only you know about

- ☐ One familiar object per child
- ☐ Glasses, hearing aid batteries, mobility aid
- ☐ Copy of ID or insurance card
